(one each for pre-teens, a women's Bible study group, and workers at the Baptist Conference Center) "We only pray for ourselves," one woman confessed. "You mean we should be praying for our nation? Our city? Our enemies? We need to start." Several women admitted, "I reach for my mobile phone first thing in the morning and never make it to my Bible, but that will change now."
