## One bag at a time...

Thank you for your help this past year! None of what God has done would've been possible without your partnership.

Generous friends across northeast Mississippi donated a mountain of supplies and, on June 29, 2017, volunteers assembled at GO Home Office to pack personal care packs for those in need. More than 500 bags of shampoo, soap, snacks, and other personal care items were assembled. I thought they were for the homeless, but I had no idea quite how that would work out. The first 25 were used for a "forgotten items" box for Eight Days of Hope (8DOH) volunteers. 200 went to Beautiful Feet ministries with a group from Calvary Baptist Church in Tupelo, Ms. The remaining bags went to Texas with a group from New Albany, Ms., who joined with 8DOH after Hurricane Harvey for rapid response disaster relief.
