We spent a week learning and serving with The Dream Center where we sorted clothes, loaded trucks with produce, handed out food to people in need, helped refurbish a home garden, and prayed.

Skid Row, 54 city blocks of tents, tarps, and people sleeping on bare concrete, is home to thousands of people experiencing homelessness. We spent time talking and praying with residents there as well as distributing new socks, t-shirts, and snacks. The stories broke my heart but I'm already putting the lessons learned into practice.

We saw people healed, hearts mended, and lives changed. Because of your generosity, we learned ways to more effectively minister to those in need.

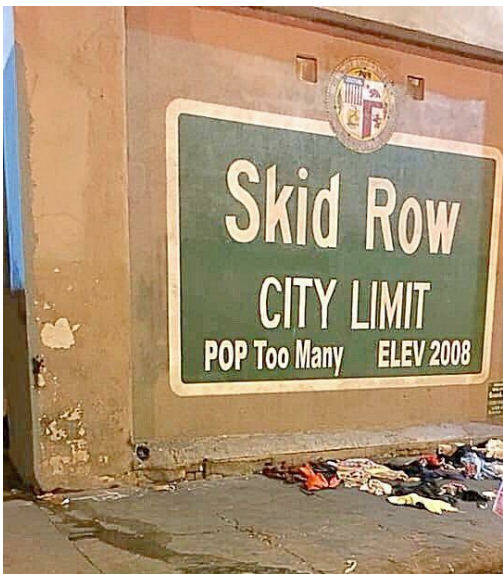


ACFW Gala



Homeless in Los Angeles

The transition from the Gala (left) to the long blocks of homelessness (right) was both shocking and sobering. 2,521 people call Skid Row home. More than 1/2 million people are currently experiencing homelessness in America. Drugs. Mental illness. Under-employed. The causes are myriad but we can help, and we must. We're working with area agencies to support the newly re-housed and help end homelessness in our area.
