

News from the Prayer Path

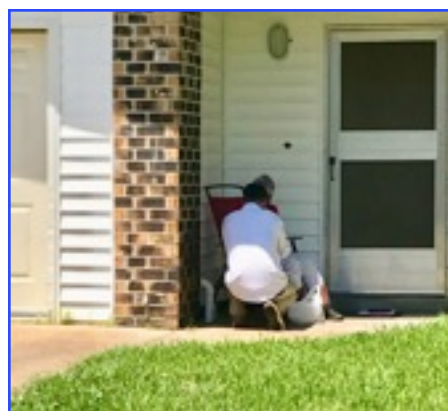
